2017 FHA Action Bill Quick-Reference

The **GREEN** bill number reflects our support and the **RED** bill number reflects our opposition.

HB1069 – Repeal the changes made by IM22.

HB1101 – Increasing the penalty for performing an abortion on a child who is capable of feeling pain.

HB1118 – Eliminate the need to prove the use of force, fraud or coercion in the human trafficking of minors.

HB1125 – Make a matter of public record the donor information of the Partners in Education Tax Credit program.

HB1143 – Ensure that a child under 16 cannot be charged with prostitution.

HB1200 – Require the disclosure of the top 50 donors of an organization which contributes more than \$25,000 to a ballot campaign.

SB55 – Protect the teaching of scientific information.

SB81 – Prohibit powdered alcohol.

SB93 – Set the marriage license fee at \$60 with a \$20 discount to any couple who receives pre-marital counseling.

SB102 – Require that a human trafficking hotline number be given to a woman seeking an abortion.

SB155 – Establish a pilot-program for state funded pre-school.

SB156 – Establish an advisory council to present the results from the above pilot-program, and oversee a state funded pre-school program.

SB149 – Protect the ability of faith-based adoption agencies to continue following their moral convictions.

SB149 – (Concurrence Vote) The House chamber amended SB149, so the Senate needed to concur and agree to the bill as amended.

SCR2 – Express support for the Electoral College.

SCR4 – Classify pornography and its effects as a public health crisis.

SCR11 – Opposing Physician Assisted Suicide.
