



Titles given reflect a description of the legislation, not the official title given by Legislative Research Council.

HB1080 - An act to prohibit doctors from prescribing puberty blockers and cross sex hormones or performing genital surgery on minors.

HB1092 - An act to redefine marriage as being between "two persons." (Committee vote used for scorecard)

HJR5006 - A resolution to place on the ballot the question of sports betting on mobile devices.

HB1157 - An act to require that state advertising dollars be used to communicate the negative effects of compulsive gambling. (Committee vote used for scorecard)

SB75 - An act to clarify that child support obligations with regard to pregnancy expenses begin at conception.

SB117 - An act to increase the video lottery bet limit and winning potential.

SCR602 - A resolution expressing support for the *Dobbs* decision from the Supreme Court.

HB1225 - An act to allow for a pregnant minor to give consent for certain treatments. (Committee vote used for scorecard)

HB1233 - An act to allow for the option of virtual schooling. (Committee vote used for scorecard)

HB1163 - An act to require that libraries adopt a policy prohibiting minors from accessing explicit materials. (Committee vote used for scorecard)

HB1116 - An act to clarify that state resources will not be used for explicit performances, and that institutions have the authority to place age restrictions on events. (Vote for motion to calendar used for Senate scorecard)

SB193 - An act to require that schools adopt a policy allowing for review of new materials and review of potentially explicit materials. (Committee vote used for scorecard)

SB57 - An act to prohibit homeschool students from open-enrolling for extra-curricular activities. (Committee vote used for scorecard)
