Explanation of Scorecard

S = A vote in support of our position **O** = A vote opposed to our position
Green Bill Title = A bill we supported **Red Bill Title** = A bill we opposed
Bill titles reflect a layman's description of the legislation, not their official titles

Age Verification (Web) - HB1053 – An act to require that explicit websites implement an age verification system to keep children off their sites

Age Verification (App) - SB180 – An act to implement age verification requirements for digital application stores, and ensure parental consent of application downloads for minors

Education Savings Accounts - HB1020 – An act to establish ESA's (Education Savings Accounts) in South Dakota

Parental Access, Medical Records - HB1061 – An act to ensure that parents have access to their children's medical records

Parental Rights - SB113 – An act to clarify that parental rights will be recognized as fundamental

House Note: The only instance where the House Chamber was presented with the original text of SB113 was in the motion to "adopt the conference committee report" and the subsequent motion "do not adopt, do not reappoint" – this vote was used in the House scorecard

Obscenity Exemptions - HB1239 – An act to remove a current exemption which enables schools, libraries and museums to ignore the "obscenity" and "harmful to minors" laws

Senate Note: The Senate Chamber did not vote on the original text of HB1239. Instead, the bill was "hoghoused" by an unfriendly amendment – this hoghouse vote was used in the Senate scorecard.

House Note: The House Chamber originally voted in favor of HB1239, but later voted in favor of the Senate's unfriendly hoghouse of the bill. The two votes were combined in the House scorecard, with half weight being given to each vote

Baby Boxes - HB1044 – An act to establish "baby boxes" for the voluntary surrender of an infant

Restroom Privacy - HB1259 – An act to protect bodily privacy in restrooms, locker rooms, and overnight accommodations

Birth certificates - HB1260 – An act to ensure that state documents such as birth certificates reflect biological sex

60% Vote Threshold - HJR5003 – A resolution, to be placed on the ballot in 2026, asking the voters if they want a 60% threshold placed on future constitutional amendments, rather than the current 50% threshold

Signature Requirements - HB1169 – An act to require that a small portion of signatures be gathered from each senatorial district for future initiated constitutional amendments

Note: After governor Rhoden's veto of HB1169, each chamber had a "veto override" vote. The original vote on the bill and the veto override vote were combined in the scorecard, with half weight being given to each vote.

10 Commandments - SB51 – An act to require the placement of the 10 Commandments in each public school classroom and require the inclusion of the 10 Commandments, Constitution, and other historical documents in public school curriculum

Senate Note: SD Family Voice Action did not endorse SB51 until after it had left the Senate, therefore the bill was not included in the Senate scorecard

Medicinal Marijuana - HB1055 – An act to require a bona fide doctor-patient relationship as a prerequisite to issuing a marijuana card

Marriage Age - SB156 – An act to prohibit marriage for 16 or 17 year olds, even if parental consent was given

Video Lottery Machines - SB205 – An act to increase the limit of video lottery machines per establishment from 10 to 15

Video Lottery Bets - SB206 – An act to increase the bet limit and winning potential on video lottery machines
